



At Rickley Park we follow the White Rose Schemes of Learning from Foundation through to Year 6.

What does a typical maths lesson look like at Rickley Park?

- Starter- this task relates to prior learning and ensures the children have retained previously taught concepts
- Focus- the small step is introduced and modelled to the children
- Guided- we practice the learning of the day altogether
- Independent- the children demonstrate their understanding through carefully planned tasks

What do our books look like at Rickley Park?

- The journey of the lesson is recorded in the books- it may come in the form of a photograph, a blurb or through a written task
- Intervention is recorded, it's used to close a gap or challenge the children further with their learning
- Presentation is important to us at Rickley Park

What do our learning environments look like at Rickley Park?

- Our working walls show current learning; the children are encouraged to refer to them during the lesson for support
